### **Performer's Release (Children)**

**Title of film/production:** Splashtastic movie making workshop

**Production Company:** Gavin Christensen t/as OOSH TV.

You, being the parents/legal guardians of Performer (the Performer and parent/guardian are together referred to as **You**) agree as set out below.

1. You grant to the Production Company the right to make an audio-visual recording of the Performer's participation or performance in the film (**Video Footage**).
2. You agree that the Production Company owns all rights in all media throughout the world in the Video Footage and you agree to sign any documents necessary to give effect to this clause.
3. To the extent necessary, You grant the Production Company the right and unrestricted permission to use, which includes the right to reuse, display, distribute, transmit, copy or otherwise exploit, or authorise such use of the Video Footage in whole or part, either digitally, or in any other medium which is or becomes available in the future, for any purpose and without restriction. The grant includes the rights to use the Video Footage on OOSH TV's YouTube channel.
4. You authorise the Production Company to use and authorise the use of the Performer's name, likeness, voice and biographical material and any objects, documents or materials presented or used by Performer during the making of the Video Footage, in connection with any use of the Video Footage. You understand that the Production Company may or may not use the Performer's name in conjunction with that of the producer or Production Company.
5. You agree that there are no restrictions that prevent the Performer from participating in the Video Footage and agreeing to these terms, and that the consent of no other person is required to enable the Production Company to make and exploit the Video Footage.
6. You release and indemnify the Production Company, its employees, agents, directors, representatives, assignees, and licensees from and against any claims arising from or in connection with the use of the Video Footage under this agreement including any claims for invasion of privacy, right of publicity and defamation.
7. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of New South Wales and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that state.

### **DECLARATION**

Workshop attendance constitutes agreement that I have read, understood, acknowledge and agree to the above terms.
